CHAPTER-XVII. FORESTRY EDUCATION

MANDATE:

The main functions of the Directorate are:

Supervision of FRI – Deemed University which at present is running post graduate and deploma courses in forestry and doctoral programmes; arranging educational and training programmes to generate trained human resource; providing support to universities imparting forestry education.

National Training

Following local training programmes were organized by the Directorate during the year 1999-2000.

International Training_:- This has been an integral component of World Bank FREE project aimed at exposing scientists and foresters of ICFRE to the latest advancements in the field of forestry research, new methods & approaches to the research and in use of advance research equipment. A total of 324 training slots amounting to Rs. 515.6583 million were provided for this purpose in the FREE project. So far 324 training slots have been utilized.

An in-house –team consisting of balanced representation of Forest Managers and Scientists has been constituted in Oct. 1999 to review and modify it. HRD plan is being developed.
