

A group of school students visited Advanced Research Centre for Bamboo and Rattan

A group of 150 school students of Youth Ministry from Presbyterian Church, Chanmari, Aizawl, Mizoram visited Advanced Research Centre for Bamboo and Rattan (ARCBR), Bethlehem Vengthlang on 9th April 2016 to learn about Bamboo and Rattan and various research activities of ARCBR.

In the conference hall of the centre Sh. Hans Raj, Scientist – C briefed the students about ARCBR and its research activities. He also gave a presentation on Bamboo, its significance and uses and emphasized to domesticate the bamboo like other agricultural and horticultural crops.

Sh. Sandeep Yadav, Scientist – B gave a presentation on Bamboo and Climate Change and emphasized on using bamboo and bamboo charcoal as a alternative over wood and coal.

Later the students visited the bamboo and rattan trail of ARCBR and get acquainted with the different species of bamboo and rattan. A field demonstration was also given to them on bamboo and rattan propagation in nursery site of the centre. They were also briefed about the low cost vermicomposting technology.
