

Two Days Farmers Training on “Bamboo and Rattan Cultivation and Preparation of Bamboo Charcoal.”

A group of 30 farmers from three localities namely Bethlehem Vengthlang, Chite Veng and Armed Veng South were gathered in this event. Sh. L. Murray, State Mission Director, NABM was the Chief Guest and Scientists of ARCBR along with Sh. Rongura Hrahsel, Range Officer, Sairang were the resource persons. The main objectives of this training was to give awareness on the importance of bamboo and rattan cultivation and its economic importance.

Inaugural session started with the welcome address by Sh. Sandeep Yadav, scientist – B followed by felicitation of the chief guest. A brief introduction about the research activities being carried by ARCBR was presented by Sh. Hans Raj, scientist – C and i/c-Director of the centre. On this occasion, chief guest gave a short speech on the importance of bamboo also emphasised the application of bamboo as an alternate source of raw materials in carpentry and wood based industries. He also emphasized that there is a huge demand of bamboo charcoal and urged the farmers to learn the techniques and concept of bamboo charcoal making and adopt in their field. Sh. Hans Raj, Scientist C made a presentation on Bamboo and its industrial uses. Sh. Rongura Hrahsel delivered a presentation on Bamboo nursery management and Plantation technique. Sh. H. R. Bora, Scientist B also gave a brief lecture on Rattan its scientific cultivation. Lalmuankima, Lab.Asst, demonstrated the micro propagation of bamboo in the Tissue Culture Lab of the centre. Sh.Sandeep Yadav, Scientist B also gave presentation on Bamboo charcoal and its uses. Project Assistants of ARCBR, namely Lalthanpuia, Michael Lalmalsawma and Zohmingliana assisted in translation to local language.

Various machines, Brick, Cement, cloth, hardware, etc are some goods for taking Entry Tax. For those who is to import such kind of goods to give an Entry Tax at Taxation Department. The fund received from this tax by the government will be utilized for Infrastructure Development, the official sources said today.

ENT microsurgery offers simple, scar-less option
Most hearing problems totally curable

Hearing impairment is a very common problem which is not only embarrassing, but leads to loss of confidence, reduced efficacy and vigour. It can be of different types. The good news is most types of deafness are completely curable.

"Impaired hearing caused by repeated infections of the nose and throat leading to collection of fluid in the middle ear can be cured by a small microsurgery like myringotomy (a surgical procedure in which a tiny incision is created in the eardrum to relieve pressure caused by excessive build-up

of fluid, or to drain pus from the middle ear) and grommet (tiny plastic tubes) insertion, which prevents adhesion and permanent damage to the ear. Sometimes road traffic accident trauma over the ear, like impact or injury by a sharp object, can damage the eardrum and lead to hearing loss," says Dr. Archana Ranade, ENT Surgeon, AGH, Kolkata. "Sometimes nasal problems like a deviated nasal septum, adenoid, polyps, nose tumour, chronic sinusitis can cause ear discharge, leading to perforation and damage to the ossicles,

causing hearing impairment. In such cases, these precipitating conditions need to be treated first by simple surgeries and then eardrum repair, so that the patient gets permanent relief. Most of the patients neglect these symptoms, which aggravate the problem," Dr. Ranade points out.

Sometimes this infection can be dangerous if it spreads to the adjacent bone. After destroying the bone, it can spread to the brain. Hence, early consultation and treatment is necessary to prevent deafness and other complications.
