The Forest Research Institute (FRI), Dehradun is a pioneer Institute in the field of research and technology dissemination on national and international level. It has developed extension media for in-situ dissemination of knowledge to different categories people. The model village Shyampur adopted by the Institute is working as a demonstration and dissemination centre for people. Many dignitaries visited the village from time to time to have a look on scientific interventions done in the village specially, high tech nursery and processing unit for vermin-composting, bee keeping and cultivation of medicinal and edible mushroom, etc.
