Training on Designing and Analysis of Plantations To The Officials of the Karnataka Forest Department

IFGTB is organizing a two-day training programme on designing and analysis of plantations for the officials of the Karnataka Forest Department on 19-20 December, 2012. Dr. N. Krishnakumar, Director, IFGTB in his address emphasized the need for such programmes wherein the forest departments and the scientist could come together on a platform and share their experiences which would enable effective lab to land transfer of technologies. Shri G. Selva Kumar, APCCF, Karnataka Forest Department expressed is gratitude to IFGTB for organizing the training for the officials. Dr. Kannan C.S. Warrier, Course Co-ordinator, elaborated on the course theme. The training dwells on the importance of usage of quality planting stock in any forestry operations including plantation forestry, afforestation and reforestation programmes. It will provide information on designing of various plantations including clonal seed orchards, seedling seed orchards, and progeny trials. Methods to be followed on development of seed production areas and IFGTB's experience in the same shall be discussed. The participants will be given a field exposure to the various types of plantations established by IFGTB. Methods to be followed in precise data collection and various analytical techniques used in data processing have also been included in the training programme.
