




Fifth International Casuarina Workshop

03-07, February 2014, Mamallapuram, Chennai

The Institute of Forest Genetics and Tree Breeding, Coimbatore organised Fifth International Casuarina Workshop at Mamallapuram from 3rd – 7th February 2014. Dr. V. Rajagopalan, Secretary, MoEF, Government of India inaugurated the workshop. During the inaugural address he stressed on the Green India Mission which focuses on the increasing the tree cover in India. Under the Mission, 5 million ha. area will be brought under green cover and in another 5 million ha. area of forest, the quality of vegetation will be improved. India is signatory to REDD+ programme. Through afforestation programmes, issues concerning the climate change will be addressed. Currently, 22% of the land area is under forest cover. To achieve the 33% of area under forest cover, he said the agro-forestry species like Casuarina assumes greater importance.

Dr. N. Krishnakumar, IFS, Director, Institute of Forest Genetics and Tree Breeding, Coimbatore invited the participants from different institutions from throughout the country and abroad. He explained the gathering about the long-term improvement efforts and commitment of IFGTB. He also narrated the importance of Casuarina in India.
