The theme for International day of the world's indigenous peoples is “**The Role of Indigenous Women in the Preservation and Transmission of Traditional Knowledge**”. Shri E. Venkat Reddy, IFS, Head Extension explained the objective of this program and the importance of Indigenous people and culture etc. A total of 08 Officers/ Scientists and Technical staff participated in this program.

The seminar started with a brief introduction and the detailed presentation includes:

Rights of Indigenous Peoples, Articles & Themes, Protection of rights of indigenous people in India, Policy of isolation, Policy of assimilation, Policy of integration, Welfare programs for schedule tribes, Constitutional safeguards, Tribal sub-plans, Economic programs & facilities, Forest right act, Different tribes, and their lifestyles (The Aboriginal tribes of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, The great Andamanese, The Onges, The Jarawas, The Sentinelese people, The Shompens, The Nicobarese, Aborigines of Australia), etc.
