TRAINING REPORT ON

Low Cost Vermicomposting Techniques

VENUE: FRCLE, GANDHIGRAM, AGARTALA

DATE: 10-11-2022

Forest Research Center for Livelihood Extension, Agartala organized a training programme on 10th November, 2022 at FRCLE, Gandhigram. The training programme started with welcome address by Shri Niren Das, ACTO & Training Co-ordinator, FRCLE, Agartala followed by the introduction of 20 participants. The participants were from different villages of South Tripura district of Tripura. Sh. Das delivered a detailed presentation on vermicomposting and mentioned that there is a growing realization now that the adoption of economical, eco-friendly and sustainable farming practices can improve productivity and contribute to environmental protection. He emphasized to commercial production as the raw materials required for establishment of the low cost vermicomposting unit are abundant in the local area. The hands-on training programme and practical demonstration were conducted. The technical details on Vermicomposting techniques involving construction of bamboo vermicomposting unit and its establishment using locally available resources were practically demonstrated by Shri Sameer Acharjee, Master Trainer. Eisenia fetida, the preferred and suitable earth worms is also added in newly established vermicompost production unit. The valedictory session was chaired by the Chief Guest Shri Arunav Banerjee, In-Charge (skill development), CIPET:CSTS, Agartala. Participants had expressed their satisfaction and desired more training in future. An interaction session was also held with the participants and taken participants' feedback. Training on Vermicomposting comes to an end with valedictory address by Shri Arunav Banerjee and distribution of certificates to the participants.
