At the outset, Dr. Devendra Kumar, Scientist E and Coordinator programme “PRAKRITI”, Extension Division, FRI welcomed the all the teachers and gave brief introduction about Forest Research Institute, Dehradun and technologies developed by Scientists in last 100 years.

He invited to Mr. Mahaling, IFS, Head, Extension Division, FRI for addressing the gathering. He spoke about the significance of conservation of flora and fauna particularly birds’ elephants, Tigers, and other Natural wilderness areas including rivers, hills and mountains and reflected on various aspect of interdependent coexistence of different species and how current economic development is influencing structural and functional integrity of the natural ecosystem.

Later Dr. Charan Singh, Scientist F, Extension Division, FRI was invited for briefing about museums of FRI. He briefed about every museums, artifacts and technologies of FRI shown there. He also shared his experience of Agroforestry and its recommended models applicability.
