Kalita, Head, Extension Division, RFRI and Coordinator, Demo Village Programme briefly spoke about the training programme. It was followed by the technical session on ‘Agarwood: Its importance, Nursery and Cultivation Management’ conducted by Dr. R. K. Borah, Director of the Institute who covered wide range of topics such as Artificial Induction of Agarwood, Legal requirements for cultivation, export of Agarwood etc

The hands-on practice of drilling holes followed by artificial inoculation of the fungal inoculum in different trees was manually demonstrated by Rajib Kumar Kalita, Kajal Gupta and Gurpreet Kaur.

At end of the training, certificates were distributed to the participants.
