## Significant Research Findings

### ICFRE-Forest Research Institute, Dehradun

- About 60 gall infested plants of *Ageratina adenophora* were collected and 40 of them were kept for rearing of Stem Gall fly *Procecidochares utilis* in cage, in which 04 female & 02 male gall flies emerged and parasitoids (05 Braconids+01 Pteromalid) died and were also recovered by dissecting the unemerged galls.

### ICFRE-Institute of Forest Genetics and Tree Breeding, Coimbatore

- New microsatellite DNA markers were developed from the transcriptome sequences generated from *Myrtogyne parvifolia* for genetic diversity studies.
