Significant Research Finding

ICFRE- Forest Research Institute, Dehradun

- Seed viability and storage period of Bambusa bambos and Dendrocalamus strictus were extended for more than 24 months through lowtemperature storage techniques.
- Nutritional analysis of Pyrus pashia and Ficus palmata viz. Moisture, Ash, Fibre, Fat, protein, TSS and Vitamin C were determined. Molu jam, Molu pickle, Molu murraba and Molu squash were prepared from Pyrus pashia fruits, shelf life study being conduct.

ICFRE- Institute of Wood Science and Technology, Bengaluru

 Installated Bamboo processing machines in the primary bamboo processing centre at Mizoram and Meghalaya training was provided to stake holders. In Exploratory studies on the addition of different fire retardant chemicals in different stages for the development of fire retardant plywood, Ammonium poly phosphate with 10%, 20% &30% concentration were used for veneer treatment of Eucalyptus, Poplar, Rubber wood and Melia-dubia. retention and better flammability were achieved in medium density wood species (Rubber wood, Poplar and Melia-dubia). Tricresyl phosphate was added in the resin system to improve the fire retardant property. 20% & 30% of ammonium poly phosphate yielded better flammability in all species; 2% of tricresyl phosphate yielded the better results in flame penetration and rate of burning as per the IS 5509.
