I hope that this issue of ICFRE Newsletter will give new useful information to our forestry sector organizations, other partners and all stakeholders.



Grant-in-Aid

ICFRE has been giving Grant-in-Aid to various forestry research universities/ institutions under Agricultural Universities offering Undergraduate and Postgraduate Courses in Forestry to strengthen the infrastructure with a view to provide much needed impetus to Forestry Education in the country. During the period July to December 2010, ₹ 141.91 lakh have been released to eight Universities under this programme.

Review program of SLEM-CPP

Review of the progress of the Sustainable Land and Ecosystem Management-Country Partnership Programme (SLEM-CPP) project titled "Policy and Institutional Reform for Mainstreaming and Up-scaling Sustainable Land and Ecosystem Management in India" was held on 30th July 2010. Presentations on the project were made by the specialists working in the Program Implementation Unit (PIU) of the SLEM project. Dr. G. S. Rawat, DG, ICFRE, reviewed the progress of the project and asked the thematic consultants to focus on the tasks and the targets of the project. The review was also attended by the officers and scientists of ICFRE.

Visit of the World Bank Implementation Support Mission

The second visit of the World Bank Implementation Support Mission took place from 2nd to 5th August 2010. The objectives of the Mission were to: (i) conduct fiduciary supervision: review procurement plan and financial management documents; (ii) review and finalize the baseline study proposal and (iii) communication strategy with status of website development. The baseline study is being conducted at the programme level through a careful selection of indicators of SLEM

components viz., land degradation, biodiversity and impacts of climate change, variability on land use practices. The Mission was also apprised of the communication strategy devised for SLEM-CPP which is currently under review by the World Bank. The Mission also cleared the proposal for the development of a website dedicated to SLEM-CPP. This website will be hosted on the ICFRE server.

Brainstorming Workshop on Baseline Study

A two days Brainstorming Workshop on the Baseline Study under the SLEM-CPP was held on 29th and 30th September 2010 at ICFRE. The workshop was a part of the consultative process under the World Bank headed project at the ICFRE.

Presentations were made by the nodal officers for the SLEM field projects from ICFRE institutes and specialists at the Programme Implementation Unit at ICFRE. Significant scientific and technical inputs will be provided by the research institutes over the duration of the Baseline Study.

RESEARCH FINDINGS

Eighty five clones of *Casuarina equisetifolia* were assessed for their salt stress response under gradually increasing concentrations of sodium chloride ranging from 50 mM to 550 mM in Hoaglands solution, and highly tolerant and susceptible clones were identified. Analysis of these clones revealed that the most susceptible clones had a shoot to root ratio of sodium ranging from 1.5 to 3.6, while in the tolerant clones the shoot to root ratio was lesser than or around one indicating that shoot to root ratio of sodium could be considered as one of the markers for screening of salt tolerant casuarina clones.

Two developed SSR targeted primers in *Casuarina equisetifolia* were amplified in the 5% denatured Acrylamide gel and obtained specific product sizes.

Bio-pesticidal properties of Aegle seed oil have been identified, and oil pre-formulations have been developed. The Bio-efficacy was evaluated at 5000 and 10,000 ppm against the target teak pesticidal



Hyblaea puera in terms of larval mortality. Field level biopesticidal applications and experiments were carried out in state forest nurseries at Nilambur and Kulathupuzha, Kerala to confirm the insecticidal properties. During the field evaluation, it was observed that no further insect attack was observed in teak nurseries. The performance of bioactivity of different ranges of oil preformulations are in progress to recommend the suitable formulation for nursery application.

The newly developed SSR target sequences were deposited in the NCBI Data Library. The accession numbers of the deposited sequences in the gene bank are given as follows:

A native parasitoid, *Megastigmus* sp. acting as a potential biocontrol agent on gall insect pest, *Leptocybe invasa* in the field was detected and reported from Andhra Pradesh and Tamil Nadu.

Chromosome numbers of *Ailanthus triphysa*-a fast growing native tree species have been reported for the first time. Chromosome numbers of *Ailanthus triphysa* have been investigated cytologically (Mitotic squash have been prepared with pretreatment of root tips in 0.05% colchicine) and identified the Chromosome No as 2n=62.

Chitin synthase gene of *Hyblea purea* and *Leptocybe invasa* has been identified and partially sequenced.
