SIGNIFICANT RESEARCH FINDINGS

ICFRE-Forest Research Institute, Dehradun

- Assessment of Species Diversity of Heterocera (moths) across the Shiwalik Landscape of Northern India and Development of a Database.- A one week late winter-early spring field survey (16-23 Feb.2025) was carried out across 5 locations in Shiwaliks of Uttarakhand . Data was collected on moths using CFL Lamp on moth screen at night. A total of 20 species of moths were recorded. Data was also collected on Temperature and Relative Humidity, GPS Coordinates and Vegetation of sites. The total number species in the database now around 409 species belonging to 22 families.
- A quantitative analysis of 14 marker compounds, including 20-hydroxyecdysone, govanoside D, govanoside B, govanoside C, clintonioside B, helonioside B, protodioscin, govanoside F, pregnachaco trioside, pennogenin tetraglycoside, pennogenin triglycoside, pennogenin diglycoside, dioscin, and prosapogenin B, in *Trillium govanianum* grown in Uttarakhand was performed by using a UHPLC system (SHIMADZU NEXERA X-2 LC-30 AD, Shimadzu, Kyoto, Japan)

coupled with an ELSD Detector (Softa Model 300S). Dioscin was identified as the major compound, with concentrations (mg/g) ranging from 55.62 ± 3.04 to 245.54 ± 10.08 .

- Fatty oil was extracted and isolated from the seeds of *Corylus jacquemontii* Decne (hazelnut), collected from Bambal (Chamba) and Cherry, (Chamba), Himachal Pradesh, using the Soxhlet extraction method. The yields were determined to be 76.66 ± 0.47 (w/w) and 69.33 ± 0.47 (w/w) for the respective locations. Fatty acid methyl esters (FAMES) were then prepared and analyzed using the GC-MS technique. A total of four compounds were identified: palmitic acid methyl ester (7.40%), stearic acid methyl ester (3.10%), oleic acid methyl ester (70.53%), and linoleic acid methyl ester (18.97%) in the Bambal sample; and palmitic acid methyl ester (6.76 %), stearic acid methyl ester (2.33 %), oleic acid methyl ester (71.96 %), and linoleic acid methyl ester (18.95 %) in the Cherry sample.

ICFRE-Institute of Forest Genetics and Tree Breeding, Coimbatore

- ICFRE-IFGTB has raised a block plantation of *Gmelina arborea* with 63 open pollinated families collected from diverse regions of the country based on the phenotypic superiority. Evaluation of field performance revealed wide variations among the genetic resources. Superior growth performance was recorded in the progenies collected from Seedling Seed Orchards of Panampally, Pudukottai, Yercaud and Pannaikadu . The height varied from 2.5 to 7.5 m with a GBH of 14 to 78cm. The straightness rank a major feature for timber varied from 2 to 5.
