Significant Research Finding

ICFRE- Forest Research Institute, Dehradun

- Phytochemical extraction of *Trillium govonianum* was performed on rhizomes from three distinct morphotypes (Type I, Type II, and Type III). The extractive yield was quantified as 16.3% (Type I), 20% (Type II), and 34.5% (Type III). Additionally, the total saponin content (TSC) was determined using a UV spectrophotometer-based method, yielding concentrations of 30.97 mg/g, 34 mg/g, and 55.2 mg/g in Type I, Type II, and Type III, respectively.
- Fatty oil was extracted and isolated from the seeds of *Corylus jacquemontii* Decne (hazelnut), collected from Bambal and Cherry, Chamba, Himachal Pradesh, using the Soxhlet extraction method. The yields were determined to be 76.66±0.47 (w/w) and 69.33 ±0.47 (w/w) for the respective locations. Fatty acid methyl esters (FAMES) were then prepared and analyzed using the GC-MS technique. A total of four fatty acids were identified: palmitic acid (7.40%), stearic acid (3.10%), oleic acid (70.53%), and linoleic acid (18.97%) in the Bambal sample; and palmitic acid (6.76 %), stearic acid (2.33 %), oleic acid (71.96 %), and linoleic acid (18.95 %) in the Cherry sample.

ICFRE- Institute of Forest Productivity, Ranchi

- Selection and evaluation of 97 CPTs of Kusum (*Schleichera oleosa*) for oil and oil-yielding traits in 3 states of W.B., Jharkhand and Bihar was done. Oil extraction from seed samples of collected Kusum CPTs were performed through Soxhlet oil extraction method. An average of 25-

37% oil content was observed from the collected seed samples of Kusum CPTs. The CPTs selected from Simdega Division, Jharkhand exhibited highest oil content in terms of percentage compared to others.


