

Patron's Column

The Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education (ICFRE), Dehradun has been undertaking the holistic development of forestry research through need based planning, promoting, conducting and coordinating research, education and extension covering all aspects of forestry. In its



continued efforts of making great strides in the field of forestry research, extension and education, the Council has come up with identification of new species of spider and leaf gall parasite in addition to development of volume equations for Teak in Gujarat state.

Under BTSG- ICFRE, training workshops on National Bamboo Database web portal/ software usage were conducted for sensitization and familiarization of state bamboo mission directors of National Bamboo Mission and Divisional Level Officers of Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh, Gujarat, Rajasthan, Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Goa, Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal and Odisha state. The representatives of Council also actively participated in 21st Conference of Parties (CoP-21), at Paris and attended first regional workshop on Developing Strategies for Communication, Partnership and Monitoring REDD[†] Himalayas held at Kathmandu.

A comprehensive Intellectual Property Management Policy (IPMP) for ICFRE and its various Institutes has been approved and notified for overall decision making pertaining to issues related to Patent/Commercialization of technology. Several Institutes under council have taken initiatives to air the technologies/advisories/practices related to forestry through radio and doordarshan for their wider dissemination.

The Council has successfully completed an Integrated Community Based Forest Management Project in Bihar i.e "Samudai Adharit Samanvit Van Prabandhan Evam Samrakshan Yojana (SASVPESY)" sponsored by Planning Commission under which the plantation of poplar in Vaishali district was extended up to 78.4 lakh plants at the end of the project. Tree Growers Mela/Kisan Melas were organized by IWST, Bengaluru and RFRI, Jorhat for sensitizing various stakeholders about the technologies and processes available for dissemination. Similarly, networking activities were undertaken in collaboration with KVKs by all Institutes under the Council.

In the process of rendering scientific consultancy services to various stakeholders for effective environmental management, the Council submitted first Interim Report on Carrying Capacity Study of Saranda region in West Singhbhum District, Jharkhand and has entered into agreement with THDCIL, Rishikesh, North Eastern Coalfields (NEC), Margherita, Assam and Jasol Water Pollution Control and Treatment Trust and Balotra Water Pollution Control Treatment Research Foundation Trust, Balotra, Rajasthan.

I hope that this issue of Newsletter will provide overview of various activities being undertaken at Council.

Research Findings

- Scientists of **TFRI**, **Jabalpur** have identified new spider upto genus level: *Bomis* sp. under Family: Thomisidae.
- Scientists of **FRI**, **Dehradun** have identified a new species of *Aprostocetus* parasitizing *Pauropsylla ficicola*, a leaf gall making psyllid of *Ficus roxburghii*.
- AFRI, Jodhpur has found out that out of twelve possible combinations of three cut types (horizontal, vertical and oblique) of four sizes (1, 2, 3 and 4 cm) tried to harvest guggul gum without use of enhancers in *Commiphora wightii*, highest gum yield was recorded in 4 cm horizontal cuts. Moreover, there was no casualty in any treated plant even after nine months. Significant positive correlation between gum yield and girth size has also been observed.

₩ HFRI, Shimla under one of the ongoing research projects observed that light trap can be used for detection and effective control of *Thysanoplusia orichalcea* which affects economically important medicinal plants *Saussurea* sp. The trap efficiency for controlling the adult population varied between 60-80%.

RFRI, Jorhat under Studies on the diversity of soil borne entomo-pathogenic fungi (EPF) in different land use system of north-east India and their utility for the management of major defoliators of *Gmelina arborea* Roxb. and Aquilaria malaccensis Lamk tested the safety of promoting fungal pathogens against non-target

organisms, particularly the beneficial insects.

The potential isolates of EPF, *Beauveria bassiana*, *Metarhizium anisopliae*, *Verticillium lecanii* and *Paecilomyces* sp. were tested for their safety to Eri silkworm, *Samia ricini* and it was found that none of the fungal isolates affected the larvae of Eri silkworms.
