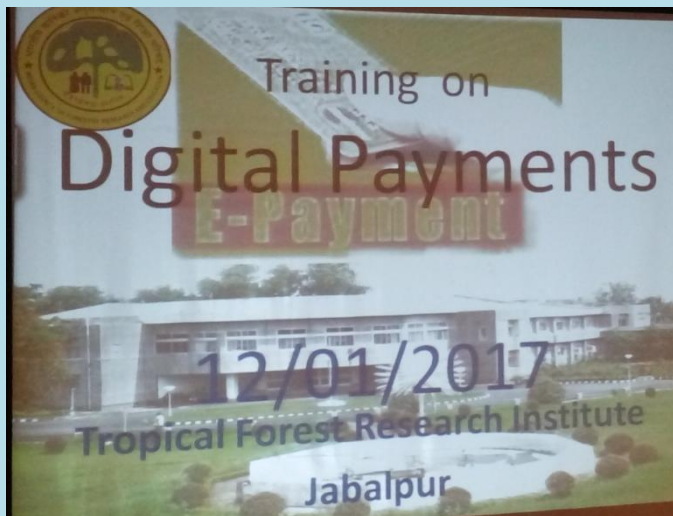


## **Tropical Forest Research Institute, Jabalpur organized Training Programme on "Digital Payments" (12<sup>th</sup> January 2017)**
